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POLE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM



The CPS Energy Pole Replacement Program proactively addresses upgrading of facilities to ensure the safe delivery of reliable electric service to our community.

Pole inspections are performed throughout the system on a routine basis; results from these inspections will determine the need for replacement.

- The scope of this pole replacement program in the City of Shavano Park includes a total of 94 utility poles.
- This first phase will include only 23 poles.

PROGRAM MAJOR ACTIVITIES



- Tree Trimming
- Pole Dig
- New Pole Installation
- Electric Outage (if needed)
- Electric transfers
- Telecomm transfers
- Old Pole Removal (AT&T, Time Warner)

NEW POLE INSTALLATION



Pole hauling trailer. Actual equipment will vary.

Access to properties is needed to bring in new poles.

OLD POLE REMOVAL



- Marked with a Red “X”
- Removal with equipment or manual process

TELECOMM TRANSFERS



- Electric lines transferred, top removed
- Telecomm will transfer their lines
- Once cleared, remove old pole

PROJECT TIMELINE



August 15th – September 30, 2018

Begin any needed tree trimming

September – November, 2018

Pole replacement work to begin

Telecomm transfers within 90 days after new poles are installed

Old poles removed within 60 days after telecomm transfers are completed

CUSTOMER COMMUNICATIONS



Customers will be contacted as needed to access properties for tree trimming, pole setting and coordinating scheduled outages.

Customers providing access to their property for tree trimming and pole setting will receive:

- Door Hanger reminders

Customers impacted by electrical outages will receive:

- Door hanger reminders
- Reminder phone calls
