On Friday, June 27, 2025, the City of San Antonio, acting by and through City Public Service Board (CPS Energy) is requesting approval from the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) to construct the Omicron 138-kV Transmission Line Project in Bexar County.

As you are aware, the Commission's CCN application requires that CPS Energy provide for review and comment a copy of the project environmental assessment (EA) to Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD) within seven days after the application is filed.
